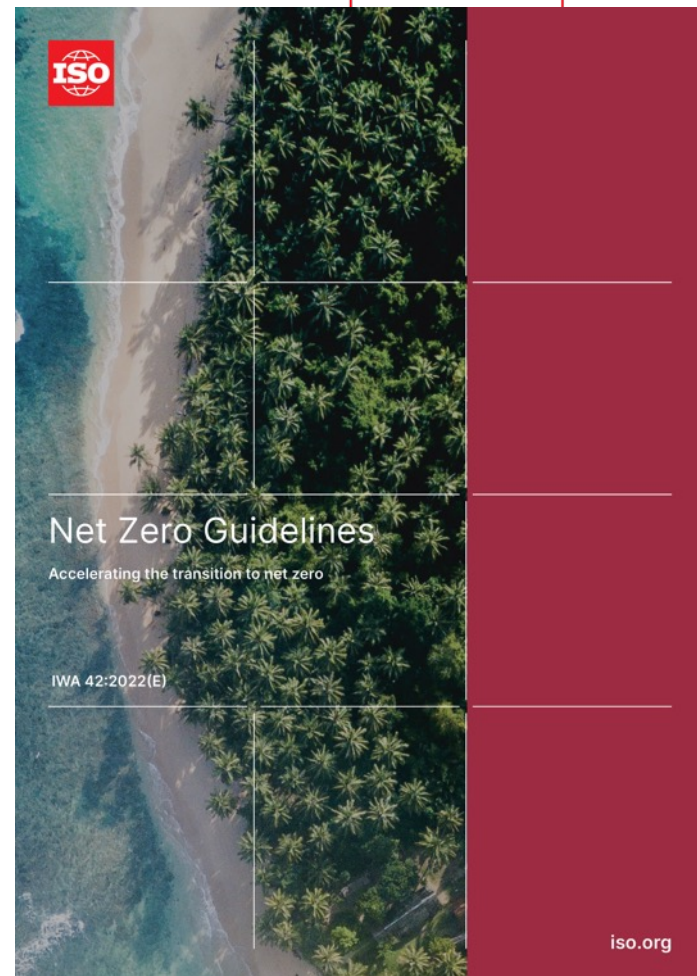

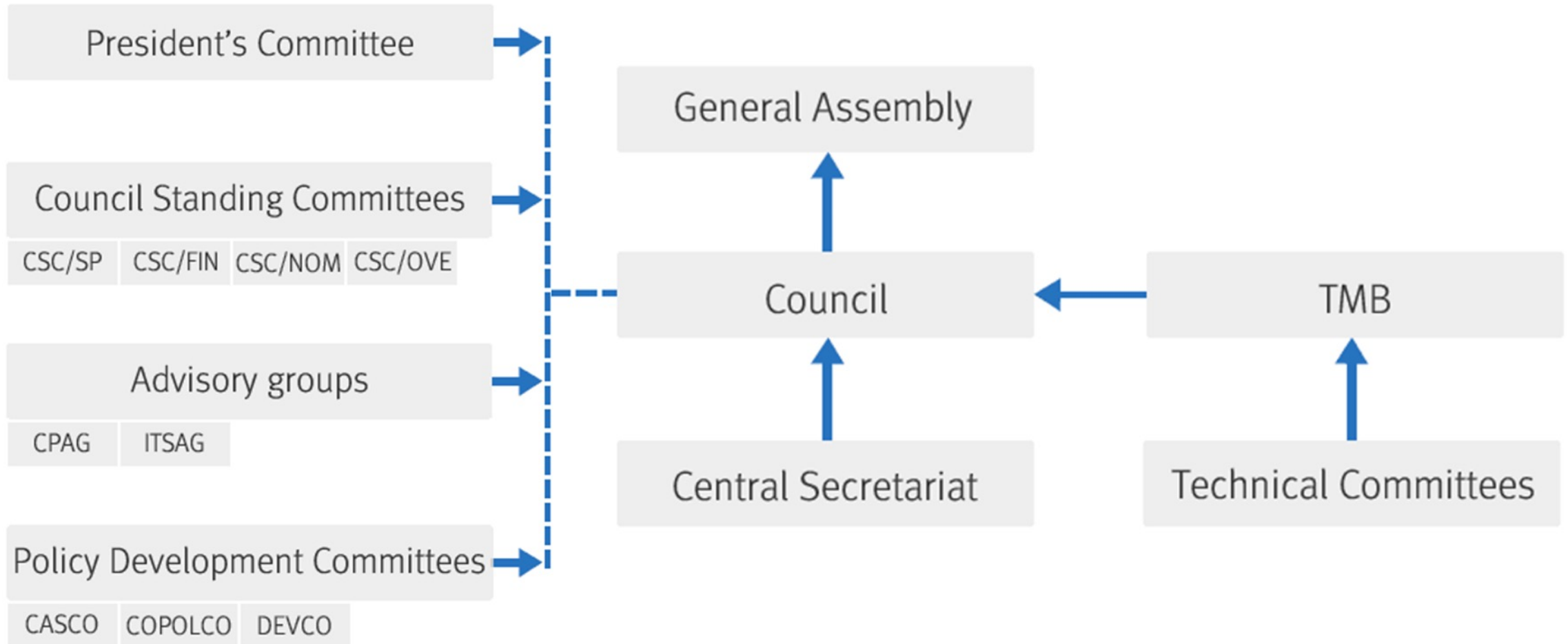
A common path to Net Zero
